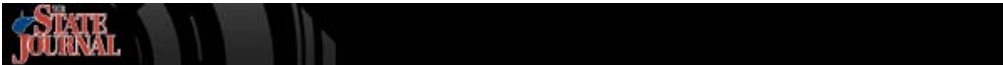

## Evans Lumber donates remaining inventory to Storehouse WV

Many items remained after Evans Lumber closed its doors to the public March 30 in South Charleston.

The store will donate its remaining inventory to Believe in West Virginia's ministry project Storehouse West Virginia.

Volunteers will spend Monday morning packing up the store's remains, loading the leftover inventory on donated trucks and transporting the goods to Storehouse West Virginia's Charleston space.

The items will then be sorted and offered to churches and charities that serve West Virginians.

Storehouse West Virginia receives new products from manufacturers and retailers then makes it available to churches and non-profit organizations at no charge.

Products are divided into two categories: gift-in-kind general products, such as personal care items, food, drinks and clothing. The second category is for building materials, and that inventory currently includes commodes, ceramic tile, windows, lighting fixtures, sinks and doors.

Storehouse West Virginia offers those building materials to nonprofits performing remodeling work or for families of clients with whom the nonprofit organizations work.

Families who need items from the storehouse must be sponsored by a non-profit organization or church.
